

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

To maintain the high standard enjoyed by our members we request you abide by our rules.

Courteous Behaviour Rule

Obscene or offensive language or behaviour will not be tolerated.

Dress Code Rules

All members' and guests' appearances must be clean, neat and tidy.

The following dress is NOT PERMITTED:

- Rubber thongs after 5pm (children under 16 years exempt)
- Bare feet
- Hats (allowed only for special occasions)
- Work apparel that is soiled or untidy
- Dirty football jerseys
- Football shorts/stubbies or similar
- Men's singlets or sleeveless shirts
- Untidy, faded, frayed or dirty clothing
- Obscene or offensive messages on clothing
- It is an offence for any person wearing or carrying a prohibited item as described in the Liquor Act 1992 under "Declared Criminal Organisation" to enter the premises and entry will be refused.

It is management's final decision on all matters relating to Dress and Behaviour.
